Services

A dedicated mentor supports parents throughout their journey with us by building an understanding of strengths, aspirations and challenges and helping to plan, monitor, and achieve each step towards identified goals. Mentors are available for face-to-face, online, and telephone support. We offer group activities for learning, peer networks, and facilitate access to local services. We review each parent's progress and satisfaction with services, advocating for any necessary changes.

Outcomes

We adapt our service to each parent's unique needs and aspirations and help parents achieve their goals with advice, connection to local services and financial support including:

- Assisting with practical needs, like training equipment, parenting supports and transport.
 - Facilitating access to quality local services.

 - Boosting confidence and motivation, offering encouragement and celebrating successes.

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Engagement / linkages

We partner with many local services, training options and cultural organisations and share knowledge across services, strengthening our support for diverse groups in Adelaide South. We hire mentors from local communities and provide ongoing training to enhance their skills.

Service access and resources

We operate from the 14 locations listed below. Mentors can also meet parents at agreed locations, such as workplaces or service points. Our sites are informal and child-friendly, including toys and activities for children.

Workforce Strategy

Our team comprises Mentors, a Site Manager, and an Engagement Coordinator, each bringing diverse backgrounds in culture, employment, and qualifications. Mentors and Senior Mentors support up to 50 parents at a time. The Site Manager oversees local operations, while the Engagement Coordinator ensures a network of local service partners meets parents' needs. All staff are supported with ongoing professional learning and development.
